## EEI Creative Arts Program Manuals

### Spring 2018 Remix Program

#### Program Description:

Our 2018 Remix Program combines the perks of small class size instruction, project-driven education, and an outstanding studio environment.

Over 10 weeks, students in the Remix Program take classes in Music Production, Sound Design, Harmony and Theory, and will have weekly individual mentoring sessions with a professional producer. Students will also attend a master class event featuring a guest speaker at our studios.

At the end of the program, each student will have completed an original remix for the song of their choice and can opt to have it promoted to blogs and magazines! This program includes:\

- 3h of class per week
- Weekly private lesson/mentoring sessions with a producer
- Remix Promotion to Blogs and Magazines
- An exclusive master class Event
- Unlimited Access to our fully equipped lab stations to work on program or personal projects\*

\*4 hours a week are guaranteed, additional studio time is subject to availability.

### Emerging Performer (36 weeks)

#### Program Description:

This program is designed for young artists who are attending high school and want to prepare for a career in entertainment, while sustaining high achievements in general education.

Providing our students with 36 weeks of training, our Emerging Performer program is a visionary combination of technical knowledge and creative, professionalizing experiences.

EEI Creative Arts offers two distinct focuses in Music Production and Artist Development.

With unique classes and specific objectives, both our majors grant our students the highest level of training and lay a solid foundation for their professional aspirations in entertainment.

This program includes:

- 360+ Curriculum hours including over 140 hours of private instruction.
- 10 hours of class per week (Individual and Group classes)
- 15 hours of recording time with an audio engineer.
- Two entirely produced covers and remixes
- One Original Single
- Mixing and Mastering by acclaimed industry professionals
- Single Promotion and Distribution
- Professional Artist Photography
- Single Artwork Design
- A unique artist website to showcase the student's music
- Privileged access to our studios and unlimited personal hours in our Lab Spaces\*

#### Music Production

10 hours of class per week:

- Music Production | 3 hours of private instruction
- Sound Design | 2 hour of private instruction
- Home Studio Engineering and Mixing | 2 hours of group instruction
- Music Business | 1 hour of Group Instruction
- Ear Training | 1 hour of Group instruction
- Harmony and basic keyboard skills | 1 hour of group instruction

#### Artist Development

10 hours of class per week:

- Vocal Development | 2 hours of private instruction
- Songwriting | 2 hours of private instruction
- Lyric Writing | 2 hours of group instruction
- Music Business | 1 hour of Group Instruction
- Ear Training | 1 hour of group instruction
- Harmony and basic keyboard skills | 1 hour of group instruction

## Semester Program (12 weeks)

### Program Description:

This 12 week program is ideal for students who have limited availability and want to make the most out of their time studying music. The condensed curriculum and shortened duration allows for both flexibility and achieving their objectives.

Also including the construction of an artistic portfolio including original music, promotion, and a personal website with materials, this program grants both the training to develop an artistry and the foundation of an artist image and brand.

This program includes:

- 6 hours of class per week (Individual and Group classes)
- One entirely produced original single
- Mixing and Mastering by acclaimed industry professionals

- Single Promotion and Distribution
- Professional Artist Photography
- Single Artwork Design
- A unique artist website to showcase the student's music
- Privileged access to our studios and unlimited personal hours in our Lab Spaces

## Sample Curricula

### Music Production

6 hours of class per week:

- Music Production | 3 hours of private instruction
- Sound Design | 1 hour of private instruction
- Ear Training | 1 hour of group instruction
- Harmony and basic keyboard skills | 1 hour of group instruction

### Artist Development

6 hours of class per week:

- Vocal Development | 1 hour of private instruction
- Songwriting | 2 hours of private instruction
- Lyric Writing | 1 hour of Private Instruction
- Ear Training | 1 hour of group instruction
- Harmony and basic keyboard skills | 1 hour of group instruction

Tuition: \$8,000

## Community Program (4+ weeks)

### Program Description:

Our community program offers access to the top-level training we offer, our studios, and the chance to be part of the EEI Creativite Arts community.

Curriculums start at 1 hour of class per week, and come in numerous variations in accordance with each student's interests. On top of classes, students are able to purchase studio time and a variety of add-ons to meet their objectives.
